He has had a successful career as a teacher, headteacher, chief education adviser and Local Education Authority (LEA) officer.

From 1992, he spent 7 years as Headteacher of West Kidlington Primary and Nursery School in Oxford, UK. It was here that the school community worked together to devise and implement a unique system of Values Education.

In 1996, Neil worked with a group of international educators at UNICEF headquarters in New York, USA, to found the education programme, Living Values. This charity works with organisations such as UNESCO to underpin education systems throughout the world with Values Education.

Neil is well known as an inspirational speaker. He is the author of *'How to Inspire and Develop Values in Your Classroom'* (LDA, Cambridge).

Values Education has a crucial role in resolving such issues as part of a long term educational philosophy

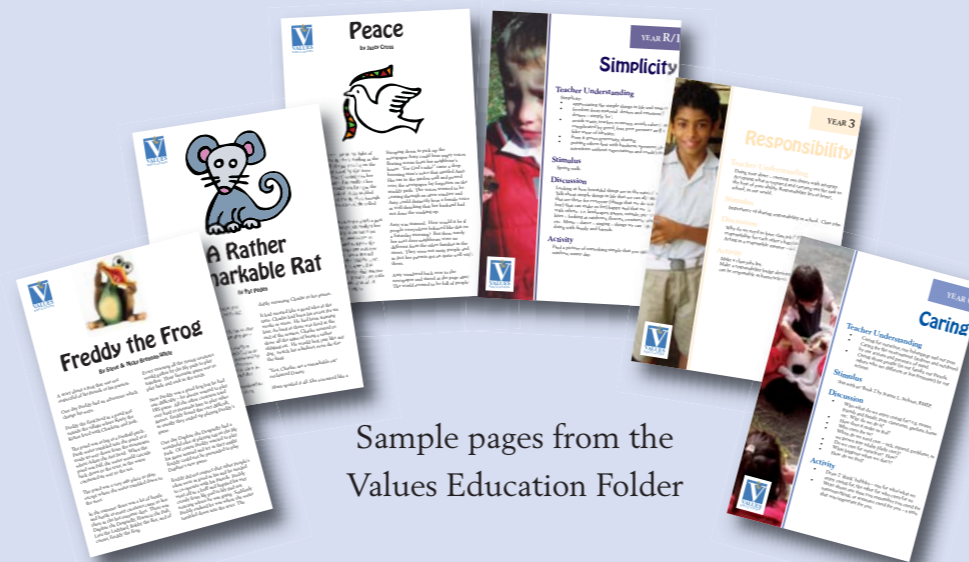
- It underpins the way a school organises itself
